

Player Code of Conduct

It is the responsibility of all adults and volunteers to comply with all rules and regulations of USA Lacrosse and its affiliated organizations (EGYL) and understand that non-compliance may be cause for discipline and/or dismissal of children, adults, volunteers, and/or other persons affiliated with the offending party.

As a player in the East Georgia Youth Lacrosse League (EGYL), I do hereby pledge to:

1. Honor the game of lacrosse and its rich history of sportsmanship.

2. Demonstrate respect to other players, coaches, parents, officials and spectators.

3. Uphold the essential elements of this code of conduct and pledge–which is honesty and integrity.

4. Demonstrate and encourage good sportsmanship and the concepts of fair play. (Derogatory comments are unacceptable. Adults involved with the game must never openly or maliciously criticize, badger, harass, touch, or threaten an official, opposing player, parent or coach.)

5. Focus on fun, participation, and healthy competition.

6. Knowledge of the agreed upon league rules must be respected and adhered to by all

who participate in the game of lacrosse, both in the letter and the spirit of the game.

7. Understand that the safety and welfare of all is the league's top priority.

This contract and pledge must be signed by any player who wishes to participate in the East Georgia Youth Lacrosse League.

By signing this document, I agree to abide by and uphold the above stated "Code of Conduct" and understand that violating this Code by either omission or commission will be subject to penalties set forth by the East Georgia Youth Lacrosse.
